

Sacred Heart CCW meeting

The quarterly CCW meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with an opening devotion entitled "Grace." The secretary's report was read and a motion was made by Barb Hussong to accept the minutes and Elaine Stenzel seconded the motion. The motion passed and the minutes were approved. The treasurer's report was read with a balance of \$1070.22 with a report of \$6617.61 of income with a current balance of \$7718.25. Maurita Volk had a bill for \$35.84 for May Baskets. There was an outstanding bill for postage of \$127.40, Styrofoam plates for \$78.09, electric knife purchase of \$29.99, a bill for \$309.71 to Hy Vee for coffee and rolls, \$21.87 to Eva Rostomily for the Lakeview Birthday Party, and \$31 for the Tri County News for fun day advertising and Elaine Stenzel had a bill of \$237.96 for quilting supplies. A motion was made by Colette Leopold and seconded by Judy Anderson to pay these bills. The motion passed unanimously.

Twenty May Baskets were delivered to shut ins by Maurita Volk. A thank you was received on behalf of the IHM seminary for the donation that was made to the Seminarian Burse. Ten bags of mulch were used for the landscaping project. Barb Hussong reimbursed the CCW for the unused bags.
